
**Resolution to Proceed:** The need for a resolution to proceed was discussed and approved by the Board.

CERTIFICATE OF MILLAGE RATE TO GEAUGA COUNTY AUDITOR  
AND REQUEST FOR REVENUE PRODUCED BY SUCH RATE  
RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Park Commissioners of the Citizens Park District, Geauga County, Ohio has determined the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten-mill limitation by levies on the current tax duplicate will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of the Citizens Park District and it is necessary to levy a tax outside of the ten-mill limitation, for the purpose of preserving, protecting, operating, maintaining and improving lands and parks of the Citizens Park District, and also acquiring additional lands and parks for the Citizens Park District, pursuant to Sections 5705.19(H) and 511.27 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the levy is at a rate of .25 mill for a five (5) year period of time and is an additional levy; and

WHEREAS, the ballot measure shall be submitted to the entire territory of the Citizens Park District and the tax shall be levied on the entire territory of the Citizens Park District and within Geauga County, Ohio;

WHEREAS, the levy is to be placed on the November 6, 2018 ballot and shall be first levied in tax year 2018 and begin collection in 2019; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY the Citizens Park District, after meeting in regular session on this 5<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2018, at Geauga West Library, that pursuant to Section 5705.03(B) of the Ohio Revised Code said Board of Park Commissioners of the Citizens Park District certifies this resolution to the Geauga County Auditor and requests that the Geauga County Auditor certify back to the Citizens Park District the total current valuation of the subdivision and the number of mills required to generate a specified amount of revenue, or the dollar amount of the revenue that would be generated by an additional levy of .25 mills, for five (5) years, for the purpose of acquiring additional lands and parks for the Citizens Park District and also preserving, protecting, operating, maintaining and improving lands and parks of the Citizens Park District, pursuant to Sections 5705.19(H) and 511.27 of the Ohio Revised Code.



Whereas on July 5, 2018, the Board of Park Commissioners of the Russell Park District passed a resolution declaring the necessity, for the purpose of proceeding, to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation under ORC 5705.19H at the rate of .25 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 0.025 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation/the mills required to generate \$66,430.00 for 5 years, and

The dollar amount of revenue that is estimated to be generated by the tax levy during the first year of collection is \$66,430.00/number of mills required to generate \$66,430.00 is .25 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 0.025 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, based on the current assessed valuation of the township of \$265,720,920.00 therefore, be it

Resolved, by the board of Park Commissioners, that the board desires to proceed with the submission of the question of a tax levy at the rate of .25 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 0.025 cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation, to the electors of Russell Township; be it further

Resolved, that the tax levy will be an additional new levy for 5 years and such levy will include a levy on the current year's tax list commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019 if approved by a majority of the entire Russell Township electors voting thereon; be it further

Resolved, the question of such tax levy shall be submitted to the electors of Russell Township at the election to be held therein on 6 November 2018; be it further

Resolved, that the fiscal officer is hereby requested to certify, not less than 90 days prior to the election, to the Board of Elections, Geauga County, Ohio a copy of the resolution of necessity and a copy of this resolution together with the certification of the Geauga County Auditor, and notify the Board of Elections to cause notice of election on the question of levying the tax to be given as required by law.


